In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lesser of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. **INSTRUCTIONS**

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners** SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

**Junior Handlers** should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? \_\_\_\_\_

## DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Services (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

## MEASURING AND HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

When filling out the entry form, there is a check box at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate if their dog needs to be measured. If your dog does need to be measured, please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List.

If a VMO or AKC Field Rep is present and measuring, dogs **must** be measured if they:

- Are under 2 years old and do NOT have a temporary height card
- Are over 2 years old and do not have at least one official measurement

The judge of record is a VMO. You are responsible for ensuring your dog is entered in the appropriate height, if no measuring occurs during the trial.

## ENTERING MULTIPLE JUMP HEIGHTS THE SAME DAY

Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers with Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

## RIBBONS AND AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

- First Place - Blue
- Second Place - Red
- Third Place - Yellow
- Fourth Place - White

Qualifying Score - Dark Green

A Rosette will be offered to all dogs finishing an agility title at these shows. Competitors earning a MACH or PACH will receive a commemorative rosette. The club reserves the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value. All prizes must be claimed by the end of the trial, none will be mailed. Competitors earning a qualifying score in both Master Standard and Master JWW (Double Q) will receive a rosette.

## ENTERING FOR EXHIBITION ONLY (FEO)

FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
  - Toys must be non-audible
  - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
  - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

## FIX AND GO ON (FNG)

Fix and Go On (FNG) allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

## OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility trials. All classes will take place indoors on soccer turf. Ring size will be 100' x 100'.

## COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. Only handlers entered in the class will be permitted on the course.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training the dog.

## EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

### SAFETY, BEHAVIOR, AND LIABILITY

- **By entering this trial**, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- The Go Dogs Agility Club, Inc., and AKC assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, injury, or death sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and assumes no responsibility for injury to children not under control of their parent(s) or guardian(s). This includes any illness associated with COVID-19.
- Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. There will be no refunds of entry fees if a person is asked to leave the trial site.
- **All dogs** must be on leash at all times when not in the ring or in the designated warm-up area.
- **Crates** may be left overnight; however, the Go Dogs Agility Club and Omaha Sports Center will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.
- **Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation** to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- **Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.**

## EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

### TRIAL SITE

- **Trial Site** will be available at 7:00 a.m. Friday for crate set up. During the trial, it will be available after 7:00 a.m. Saturday and Sunday. This trial will be held indoors on soccer turf. Bring chairs, crates, and clean up tools. Crates **must** be placed on waterproof tarps.
- Dogs must be removed from the trial site upon completion of the trial.

### FOOD

- Food will be available for volunteers. Multiple fast food locations are within 5 minutes of the trial site. **No food or beverages are allowed on the soccer turf.**

### REFUNDS

- Bitches in season are not permitted in the Trial. Entry fees less \$5 administrative fee per run will be refunded for bitches coming in season or dogs that become sick or injured after the closing date. Owner must present certificate from veterinarian to secretary prior to start of show.
- If, because of riots or civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry will be made.
- GDAC reserves the right to cancel these trials in the event of extreme weather conditions and no entry fee refunds will be made in such case.
- No refund will be issued for overpayment of \$10.00 or less

### RINGSIDE

- **Dogs may arrive** any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their classes if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.
- Judges are not required to wait for dogs. Exhibitors alone are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run

## COVID PROCEDURES

The trial site is large enough for plenty of social distancing for crate space and lining up for the ring. More specific requirements and guidelines will be sent out closer to the trial date to ensure alignment with the latest recommendations.
